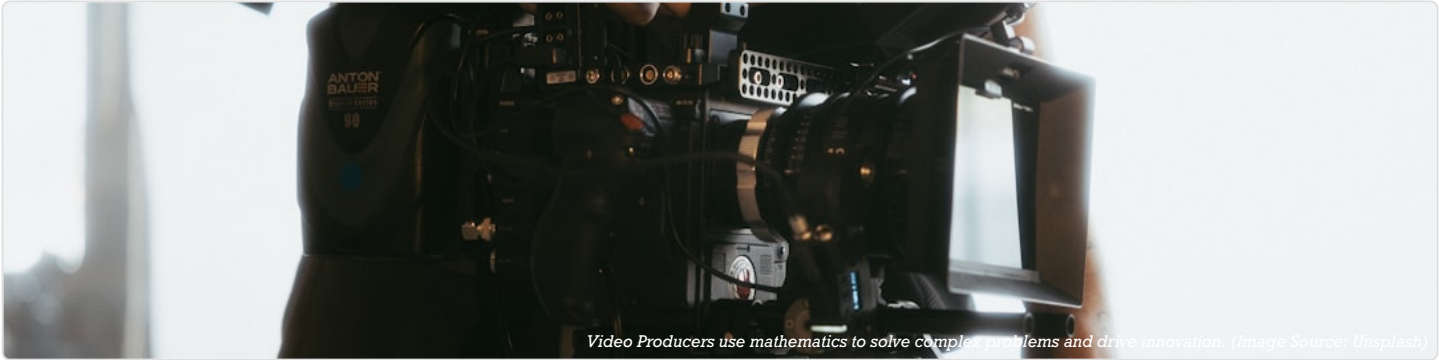


# CAREERS THROUGH MATHS: VIDEO PRODUCER



## JOB OVERVIEW

A Video Producer oversees the entire lifecycle of video content, from initial concept and budgeting to filming, editing, and final delivery. They work in diverse environments including television, film production companies, corporate marketing departments, and digital media agencies. Their role is highly mathematical, requiring precise management of resources, timelines, and technical specifications to ensure projects are completed on budget and to the highest quality standards.

Career progression often starts with roles such as Runner or Production Assistant, advancing to Production Coordinator, and then to Video Producer. Key qualifications include practical experience built through internships and a strong portfolio demonstrating successful project management.
