JOB OVERVIEW

A Legal Executive is a qualified legal professional who performs a substantial and integral role within a legal team or in-house department. Their daily responsibilities are diverse and hands-on, typically involving the management of a case-load of legal matters. Key duties include drafting and reviewing legal documents such as contracts, pleadings, and leases; conducting in-depth legal research; liaising directly with clients, witnesses, and opposing counsel; and preparing comprehensive case files for litigation or transactions. The work environment is predominantly office-based, often within law firms, corporate legal departments, or government agencies, and requires close collaboration with solicitors, paralegals, and other stakeholders under the supervision of a practicing lawyer.
